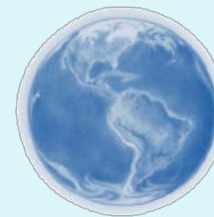

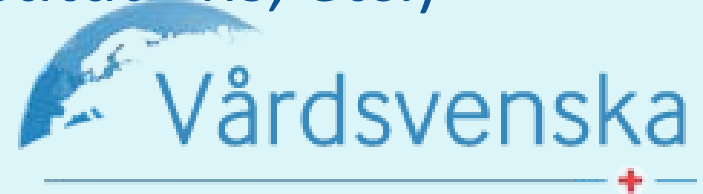
- + Information about moving to Finland

Care Personnel

Language training:

- + The **Swedish online course** has information about Swedish vocabulary, pronunciation and the basic grammar
- + Hundreds of vocabulary and grammar exercises, picture exercises, reading and comprehension, related to the health care field and basic language exercises
- + The exercises are available in **Swedish, Finnish, English and Russian**, so you can practice the same vocabulary in four languages

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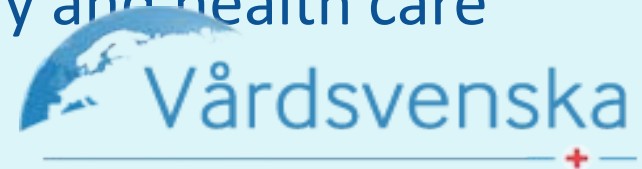
Language training:

- + As a registered user, the programme keeps a log of your achievements
- + The difficulty level is 1-2 elementary, 3-4 intermediate, 5 advanced
- + The “elderly care game” is a ten level interactive vocabulary and comprehension game. Upon completion of the last level, you will be able to print a certificate that confirms that you have completed the program. This will entitle you to attend an intensive course in conversational Swedish in Helsinki for free

Material:

- + The **material area** contains the online material for self-study, a comprehensive image gallery, pronunciation and grammar explanations, downloadable vocabulary and grammar exercises, links and information
- + You can also download glossaries on many different subject areas related to health care (aged care, dental care, medical professions, medical fields, diseases and symptoms, etc.), as well as every-day life
- + A **dictionary** with basic vocabulary and health care terminology in five languages
